

EU LEGAL SUMMER SCHOOL 2026 IN LUXEMBOURG

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

At the end of June 2026, thirty-six (36) students and young professionals will have the opportunity to participate in the second EU Legal Summer School in Luxembourg. Participants will spend one week in various EU institutions in Luxembourg, in an ambitious job-shadowing programme that combines professional training, social activities and valuable networking opportunities.

Nine (9) students and young professionals, selected by the scientific board of YOUNG FIDE 2025, will be awarded the opportunity to participate in the EU Legal Summer School among the 36 participants.

In addition, twenty-seven (27) **Master's, Phd and Postdoctoral EU law students**, namely one student per Member State, will be selected to participate in the EU Legal Summer School, following the selection procedure outlined below.

Formal requirements and deadlines:

- Applicants should have the **nationality of one of the 27 Member States**.
- Applicants should be **currently enrolled** in a Master's, Phd, or Postdoctoral course (**preferably in EU law**) at a **university located in an EU Member State**.
- Applications should be submitted to the FIDE National Association of the Member State where the applicant's university is based.

- Applicants should submit their **CV** and **motivation letter**, in English, using the provided templates, as well as a duly completed **personal information form**.
- The deadline for applications is **30 March 2026**.
- The selected candidates will be informed **by the end of May**.
